



### FAMILY CONTACT MATTERS!

- Stronger Parent Engagement
- Stronger likelihood that the child will return home and stay home
- Helps to maintain a connection to child's culture
- Provides consistency for kids
- Provides opportunities for foster parents and birth parents to connect and build relationships





### FAMILY CONTACT DEFINITION

Normalized family contact for children that is least restrictive, most family like setting; parents most family like setting; parents performing activities as they normally would; parents taking full responsibility for the safety and well-being of their children

# FAMILY CONTACT PLAN

- ✓ Level of supervision and reasons for the level
  ✓ Goal of family contact
  ✓ Schedule, frequency, duration, location and participants
  ✓ Suggested activities
  ✓ Instructions for the parent during family contact

- ✓ Procedures for emergencies and special situations.
